

2008-2009 American Association of University Women (AAUW) Scholarship

Scholarships will be awarded to WWU students in the 2008-2009 academic year by the Bellingham branch of the American Association of University Women.

Qualifications

1. Men and women WWU students who have at least 135 credits and the equivalent of senior or graduate standing as of Fall 2008. Must be enrolled for at least one quarter prior to application deadline.
2. Academic achievement. In general, only students with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better need apply.
3. Student must demonstrate financial need. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be used to determine financial need. Students should send their valid FAFSA to the federal processor by Western's priority deadline of February 15, 2008, and have a need for assistance of at least \$1,000.

Application Process

1. Complete the [SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM](#), including the Supplemental Information. The Supplemental Information items must be typed or word processed on separate sheets of paper (note the item number on the pages). Attach the Supplemental Information to the application form.
2. Obtain one to three letters of recommendation from a faculty member(s) using the [RECOMMENDATION FORM](#). The form may be copied for additional recommendations. You may submit the letters of recommendation with your completed application packet or the faculty member may mail them directly to the Scholarship Center by the deadline date.
3. Grade transcripts from all previous colleges and universities attended. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable. **Fairhaven College students, please submit copies of ALL 2007-2008 faculty evaluations along with your transcripts. Do not include current WWU transcripts.**
4. Please submit 4 completed scholarship application packets (3 copies and the original). Application packets consist of the completed scholarship application form including the supplemental information, a minimum of one letter of recommendation, and grade transcripts. Please collate your application materials in this order.

Application deadline is **April 11, 2008** (postmark is acceptable). Applicants must meet all qualifications in order for the application to be sent to the committee. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all application materials are on file in the Scholarship Center by the deadline. Late applications will not be considered.
