
2009-2010 Nahbi Ram Joshi Scholarship

This scholarship was established by one of Western's most devoted patrons, Miriam Snow Mathes, in memory of Nahbi Ram Joshi, a foreign student who passed through the University over 90 years ago.

Qualifications

1. Full-time undergraduate Western Washington University students. New freshmen and transfer students are eligible to apply.
2. Scholarship applicants must either have been born in India or have a parent or grandparent born in India.
3. Applicants must demonstrate strong leadership qualities as well as high academic merit.
4. Recipients of this award may re-apply for subsequent years.

Application Process

1. Complete the [SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM](#), including the Supplemental Information. The Supplemental Information items must be typed or word processed on separate sheets of paper (note the item number on the pages). Attach the Supplemental Information to the application form.
2. **Include a personal birth certificate or a statement (if you do not have access to a parent or grandparent birth certificate) that will verify the criteria required in #2 of the Qualifications listed above.** This statement should be typed or word processed and included with your Supplemental Information items.
3. Obtain one letter of recommendation, preferably from a university faculty member or a high school teacher or counselor, using the [RECOMMENDATION FORM](#). You may submit the letter of recommendation with your completed application packet or the Recommender may mail it directly to the Scholarship Center by the deadline date.
4. Grade transcripts from all previous high schools, colleges and universities attended. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable. **Fairhaven College students, please submit copies of ALL 2008-2009 faculty evaluations along with your transcripts. Do not include current WWU transcripts.**
5. **Please submit 3 completed scholarship application packets (2 copies and the original).** Application packets consist of the completed scholarship application form including the supplemental information, one letter of recommendation, and grade transcripts. Please collate your application materials in this order.

Application deadline is **April 10, 2009 by 4 PM** (postmark is acceptable). Applicants must meet all qualifications in order for the application to be sent to the committee. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all application materials are on file in the Scholarship Center by the deadline. Late applications will not be considered.
